JULY 9 – 11, 2021 MARINA EQUESTRIAN CENTER 2830 5th Ave, Marina CA 93933 **Description:** Due to COVID-19 we have had to revamp our regular format for D Camp into separate sessions to attempt to maximize social distancing and minimize unnecessary contact. D Camp is a fun and educational experience designed for newer Pony Clubbers, D1-D3. Mounted and unmounted participants are welcome! Mounted participants will receive mounted lessons as well as unmounted horse management lessons. The unmounted participants will receive unmounted lessons regarding riding topics as well as horse management topics.

Accommodations: If participants choose to come for the weekend, overnight horse accommodations are available. In accordance with facility rules vaccination records must be submitted prior to arrival for overnight stays. Designated overnight paddocks are large paddocks with pipe panel fencing, no cover, and deep sand footing (we are in the sand dunes). Members are expected to bring their own horse's feed and overnight equipment. There are hotels close by in Marina. Overnight camping not available on site.

Chaperones/Parents: Due to COVID-19, this year parents/chaperones/guardians will be required to assist with the tacking up and general horse care for their own child's horse. In order to minimize close contact and unnecessary touching participants will be expected to tack/untack and provide care for their own horse or can receive help from their designated chaperone/parent/guardian. Horse management quidance will be provided by instructors.

Health Concerns: If anyone residing in the household has shown signs of illness to include but not limited to fever, cough, diarrhea, body aches or soreness, loss of taste or smell, etc. within the 14 days prior to D Camp please contact Nichole – 831-239-3067 or nm84@aol.com.

Fees:

- Mounted Participant: \$100 per session, \$175 for both sessions
- Paddock Use (must submit vaccination records prior to arrival and reserve paddock):
 - **Day Use** \$25/day
 - Overnight \$40/night includes day use
- Unmounted Participant: \$25 per session
- Non-Pony Club Member: \$15

General Info:

- **Meals:** No meals provided, please plan to prepare your own meals and provide snacks. Marina is close by to purchase groceries and/or meals.
- **Weather:** Summer fog is common in Marina, especially in the mornings and evenings. Be sure to bring warm clothes and dress in layers. It can be windy. Sometimes the fog clears for a nice sunny day... sometimes it does not.
- Day Use: If only coming for 1 session, horses will be tied to trailers in the guest parking area. Paddocks available upon request for day use \$25, paddocks must be cleaned before departing.
- **Stabling**: Overnight stabling is available for \$40. Paddocks are large, uncovered pipe paddocks. No bedding allowed; footing is deep sand. Mornings and evenings can be foggy, consider bringing blankets for horses if they are used to hot weather.
- **Feed**: Participants are expected to bring whatever rations their own horse requires whether for the day or staying overnight. Feed must be kept in trailer or vehicle.
- **Trailers**: Feed and tack must be kept in trailers. Participants are expected to supply their own trailers or make prior arrangements. Trailers must be parked in assigned places. All youth participants must have a parent or guardian on-site for the entirety of D Camp or designate a responsible adult for your member prior to arrival. - **Self-care:** Not only are Pony Clubbers expected to feed and care for their own horses at rallies and Pony Club camp, Marina Equestrian Center is also a self-care facility. Any horses staying overnight will need to be fed on their own schedule. Plan to feed horses in the morning by 8am so that they have time to eat their breakfast.
