We are fortunate to have Jennette Scanlon coming for 2 prep clinics, on one day! The morning clinic will be focusing on lungeing techniques and what will be needed for this portion of the HA test. The afternoon will be Teaching to Teach with an opportunity to teach a mounted lesson with feedback. C1 and up may participate but all levels are welcome to audit!

Lungeing 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM

This clinic will be starting with a discussion on lungeing equipment and technique at the HA level, followed by a demonstration. Then 4 participants will each have a 30 minute one on one lunge session for horse and handler to practice their skills with feedback. Participants in the 30 minute sessions should be prepared to bring:

- -Your own horse
- -Lunge line, whip, other lunge equipment
- -Helmet, boots, gloves, watch

-Have horse ready to start lungeing at the start of your time slot -Any horse sharing will take the same time slot and each handler will lunge one direction

Teaching to Teach 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM

The teaching clinic will begin with a lecture and practice followed by lessons where 8 participants get an opportunity to practice teaching to peers as well as ride in the lessons the other participants are teaching. Plan to teach as well as ride during this clinic. This will give the chance to benefit from feedback on your teaching as well as feedback from the other lessons being presented. There is no need to come with a lesson plan, you will be creating it during the clinic. Participants in the teaching / riding lessons should bring their horse and tack. If you are sharing a horse, or can not bring one but would still like to participate, please let me know.

Please read the following information carefully and insure that all information is filled out and signed. **Registration must be received by Monday, June 14, 2021 (please email me that you will be attending also, so I know to watch for your registration form).** Once the prep is full, registration paperwork will be accepted in order of earliest postmark date and must be fully paid to be put on the waitlist.
