Coaches: Each SJ Team MUST have a Coach and the coach must attend the coaches briefing after the team briefing on Friday afternoon.

Chaperones: The team chaperone is responsible for overseeing social distancing compliance during rally competition. If the rally is an overnight rally, the team chaperone will be allowed in the barns during competition hours to oversee social distancing compliance, but may not be in the tack room, feed room or stalls. They may not act as a member of the team or perform any competitor related duties (*They can take a folding chair and sit outside of tack or feed stalls, but must put the chair up out of the way when not in use*). For teams with members all above the age of 18, they will be responsible for reminding each other to maintain social distancing protocols.

Volunteers: Each Team must provide at least 2 adult volunteers. HMX riders are encouraged to volunteer. We can give you a short job that can be done during your down time.

Spectators: Due to COVID-19 restrictions, no spectators will be allowed on premises. However, we will have many roles for volunteers to fill so please contact Kim Goto Miner and she will find you a job!

NOTE: All Chaperones and Volunteers must wear appropriate clothes and footwear.

Horse Management Rulebook Rule 15b.2. C3 & Higher Scheduling Option

Purpose: The upper level Competitor may have a better understanding and knowledge of the appropriate warm up time for their mount.

- C3 and higher Members who want to change their Turnout time should discuss this with the Organizer.
- The Member must carefully consider how his/her decision may affect the ride. Warm up time should be just enough to prepare the mount for work.

 Only 10 to 10
 - Standard warm up time at Camino Real Rallies is $\frac{1}{2}$ hour. Turnout times will be scheduled 45 minutes prior to your ride time. Please indicate on the Competitor Information Sheet if you are a C3 or above, would like additional time and how much additional time you would like.

Turnout Inspections during COVID-19 Protocols

The team chaperone or competitor's parent must attend turnout inspection with each competitor. After the initial presentation by the competitor, the team chaperone or parent will hold the mount. While the competitor follows the direction of the horse management staff to lift feet, raise saddle flaps, etc. for inspection. The horse management staff will not touch the member, mount, or equipment during the inspection except for extreme safety circumstances. Horse holder must be in appropriate barn footwear.
