Registration is open now and will close February 25th. Fees must be paid at the time of registration. Fees are not refundable.

Volunteers: Dressage Rally runs on volunteers! Each team must have a chaperone and at least one volunteer.

Rules:

This rally will be governed by the 2022 USPC Horse Management Handbook, the 2022 USPC Dressage Rulebook, and associated Newsletters. All competitors must adhere to the rules.

Teams: Teams shall consist of 3 or 4 riding members at any level and an unmounted stable manager. Each team must have a chaperone (21 or older, chaperones may also be volunteers). Senior competitors (18 and up) do not require a chaperone. If a club does not have a complete team, the rally secretary will combine them with members from another club.

Championships Divisions—Minimum Age and Certifications to be eligible for Championships, competitors must meet the age parameters and minimum certifications for the offered Championships divisions. There are no age and no certification exceptions to the below requirements. See Article 5 for more details on age and certification minimums.

Modified Junior Training Level D-2 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 10-17

Junior Training Level C-1 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 12-17

Modified Senior Training Level D-2 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 18+

Senior Training Level C-1 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 18+

Modified Junior First Level and Up D-2 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 10-17

Junior First Level and Up C-1 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 12-17

Modified Senior First Level and Up D-2 DR/Flat/EV/HSE/WST 18+

Senior First Level and Up C-1 DR/Flat/EV/HSE /WST 18+

Stable managers must meet the minimum age criteria of their division, and be a D-2 HM for modified divisions and a D-3 HM for all other divisions.

NOTE: Dressage competitor MUST BE AT LEAST 10 YEARS OF AGE as of JANUARY 1, 2022 and rated D2 or higher to compete at 2022 USPC Championships. There will be no Intent to Qualify forms. Top competitors who meet age and rating criteria will be asked to respond if they would like to compete in the 2022 USPC Championships.

Dressage Tests: All Intro level tests and Training Level 1 & 2 will be ridden in short court (20m x 40m). Training level 3 and up will be ridden in the long court (20m x 60m). Riders not intending to qualify can choose 2 tests and perform a musical freestyle. You only need 1 qualifying score at the test of your level and a musical freestyle to qualify, but you have two opportunities to ride that test to get your score.

Coaches: Coaches are not required but encouraged. A coach must sign and adhere to the Coaching Form and form must be submitted with your entry. A Chaperone is not permitted to coach.

Longeing: USPC rules for longeing apply.

Stabling: Stalls are required for the rally, cost is \$75.00 and one bag of shavings will be provided Tack stalls/feed stalls will be provided, cost is \$25.00 a stall. Stalls must be stripped at the end of rally.

Registration will close on February 25th!

Note to DCs & CAs:

Please promote the rally to your members. Make sure they understand the criteria for qualifying for championships.

- Determine the team make-up (name of the team, team members, captain). Make sure each participant is aware of it. If you do not have a complete team, we will help place your members in team with other clubs.
- Help your members prepare for the rally.
- Each team needs to have a chaperone and volunteer!

As USPC members above the age of majority are adults in the eyes of the law and therefore responsible for themselves; USPC does not require a “chaperone” for these members at competitions. USPC does require that members above the age of majority submit Emergency Contact information for each competition. Age of majority varies per state.

SECTION VI: Appendices

Chaperone duties shall include:

1. The primary function of the "Official Team Chaperone" is to ensure that there is a contact person for every USPC member below the age of majority, on the grounds for the duration of the competition.
 2. While multiple Chaperone Forms may be turned in for a single team, only one person will be designated the Official Team Chaperone. If the Official Team Chaperone must leave the grounds during the competition, they must delegate the team chaperone duties to another responsible adult, making it clear that they are to respond to rally officials and any team members in your absence.
 3. Be present and available to rally officials and all team members for the duration of the competition.
 4. Being in contact with parents/guardians for all team members during competition hours.
 5. Being in contact with all team members and their parents/ guardians outside of competition hours.
 6. Have copy of and be familiar with the current discipline rulebook and the current Horse Management Handbook and Rules for rallies. Rulebooks available for download from www.ponyclub.org.
 7. Be aware that USPC members are required to wear a current, up to date USPC medical card/bracelet on their arm at all USPC activities.
 8. Be familiar with the effects of heat and humidity and the potential risk for heat related illness. Take an active role in helping to keep all team members well hydrated and take every opportunity to encourage water breaks.
 9. Uphold USPC Substances and Weapons Policy which prohibits the inappropriate or illegal use of any substance, including but not limited to drugs or alcohol, by anyone participating in any manner. Weapons of any kind are forbidden. Refer to About/About the Organization/By-Laws, Policies and Resolutions on www.ponyclub.org for the full policy statement.
 10. Remember that administration of medications is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian.
